
Removal and Installation

REMOVAL


NOTE: In the event the headliner is damaged or creased during removal, it will need to be replaced with a new headliner. Use clean gloves or make sure your hands are clean before removing the headliner.

- 1. Disconnect and isolate the negative battery cable.
- 2. Open the screw covers (1), remove the screws (2) and the grab handles.


NOTE: It is NOT necessary to remove the front grab handles if only removing the rear headliner.



- 3. Using a trim stick or equivalent, remove the rear striker cover (1).
- 4. Remove the C-pillar trim panels (3) (Refer to 23 Body/Interior/PANEL, C-Pillar Trim/Removal and Installation).
- 5. Loosen the weatherstrip at the top of the door openings.
- Loosen the top of the upper B-pillar trim panels (4) (Refer to 23 - Body/Interior/PANEL, B-Pillar Trim/ Removal and Installation).
- 7. Remove the push fasteners (2).
- 8. Lower the rear headliner (6) and disconnect the wire harness connectors, then remove.




- Remove the overhead console (Refer to 23 Body/ Interior/CONSOLE, Overhead/Removal and Installation).
- 10. Remove the A-pillar trim panels (4) (Refer to 23 Body/Interior/PANEL, A-Pillar Trim/Removal and Installation).
- 11. Remove the push fastener (1) and remover the front headliner (2).




INSTALLATION

- 1. Position the front headliner (2) and install the push fastener (1).
- 2. Install the A-pillar trim panels (4) (Refer to 23 Body/ Interior/PANEL, A-Pillar Trim/Removal and Installation).
- Install the overhead console (Refer to 23 Body/ Interior/CONSOLE, Overhead/Removal and Installation).



- 4. Raise the rear headliner (6) and connect the wire harness connectors.
- 5. Install the push fasteners (2).
- Attach the top of the upper B-pillar trim panels (4) (Refer to 23 - Body/Interior/PANEL, B-Pillar Trim/ Removal and Installation).
- Install the C-pillar trim panels (3) (Refer to 23 -Body/Interior/PANEL, C-Pillar Trim/Removal and Installation).
- 8. Install the rear striker cover (1).
- Install the weatherstrip at the top of the door openings.
- Position the grab handles (5) and install the screws.
 Tighten the screws securely then install the screw covers.
- 11. Connect the negative battery cable.





PANEL, Quarter Trim Removal and Installation REMOVAL


- 1. Fold the rear seat (1) forward.
- 2. Lift and remove the rear door scuff plate (2).



3. Remove the screw (1), then use a trim stick and remove the quarter trim panel pocket (2).




- 4. Remove the seat belt lower anchor bolt (4).
- 5. Remove the screws (1, 2, 5).
- 6. Using a trim stick or equivalent, loosen the quarter trim panel (3).
- 7. Disconnect the wire harness connectors and remove the quarter trim panel.




INSTALLATION

- 1. Position the quarter trim panel (1) in the vehicle and connect the wire harness connectors.
- Push the quarter trim panel to engage the retaining clips.
- 3. Install the screws (1, 2, 5) and tighten securely.
- Install the seat belt lower anchor bolt (4) (Refer to 10

 Restraints/RETRACTOR, Seat Belt/Installation).



5. Install the quarter trim panel pocket (2) and tighten the screws (1) securely.



6. Install the rear door scuff plate (2).
